- You will notice on your rocker there are 4 rows of button head cap screws.
- The top row is used to hold the rocker to the Jeep and should not be tampered with after initial rocker installation.
- The other three rows should have 4 button head cap screws in each row. (Indicated by arrows)
- Each mounting surface offers 2 different angles depending on which way you position the step.
- There are 6 different mounting positions total.
- You can use the button head cap screws for mounting the step on the street, but for serious off road use it is recommended to use the supplied grade 8 hardware.
